

Trailside Instructor (SCF)

I. Requirements

The Trailside Instructor must:

- A. Have prior experience in environmental education, teaching, child care or other related field.
- B. Have a valid certification in Adult and Child CPR and First Aid.
- C. Have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record.
- D. Be 16 years or over.

II. Program

Duties Include:

- A. Maintaining the standards of the American Camping Association.
- B. Working toward accomplishing the mission and goals of Trailside Discovery Camp and The Alaska Center for the Environment.
- C. Working with the additional Environmental Education Instructors, SCF Manager to provide high quality education experiences to all Trailside Discovery Camp participants.
- D. Preparing lesson plans and implementing environmental education programs and activities as needed.
- E. Supervising participants and ensuring the safety of all staff and campers.

III. Child Care

Duties Include:

- A. Recognizing and appropriately responding to hazards and emergencies.
- B. Maintaining ACA standards for instructor to camper ratios.
- C. Encouraging the personal and social development of children.
- D. Observing children and reporting all accidents, significant illnesses, and/or signs of physical, emotional, or sexual abuse to the Camp Director.
- E. Participating in pre/after care as needed.

IV. Records

Maintain accurate records:

- A. Protect the confidentiality of the participant's records.

V. Supervision and Support

The Instructor reports to the Lead Instructor.

VI. Attendance

The Instructor must:

- A. Attend staff training.
- B. Attend all staff meetings.
